- I understand that all students going on this trip will be responsible in conduct to bus driver, teacher, or adult sponsors. It is further understood that the students will go and return from the event on the transportation provided and that every reasonable caution will be maintained on the trip.
- I hereby acknowledge that I have been advised that the activities involves in this excursion/ field trip or event are are not considered by the district to be of "high risk" to the participants.

Education Code 8835330 provides as follows :

"All persons making the field trip or excursion shall be deemed to have waived all claims against the district or the State of California for injury, accident, illness, or death occurring during or by reason of the field trip or excursion. All adults taking out-of-state field trips or excursions shall sign a statement waiving such claims."

In accordance with this statute, and in consideration of my son/daughter's participation in said field trip or excursion, I hereby release the Sweetwater Union High School District, its officers, employees and agents from and waive all claims for injury, accident, illness, death, or property damage occurring during or by reason of said field trip or excursion, **and arising from any cause whatsoever, including illegal acts of third parties, terrorism, or act of war,** except for any claims bases upon the fraud, willful injury to person or property, or violations of law by the District, its officers, employees and agents, and further agree to indemnify and hold harmless the District, its officers, employees and agents from any claims and actions for damage or injury which any person may assert by reason of my son/daughter's conduct while participation in said field trip or excursion.

Cold sack lunches are available from the school cafeteria. Students who qualify may receive meals at no cost. All others must purchase or bring lunch.

In the event of any illness or injury to my son/daughter, I hereby consent to whatever x-ray, examination, anesthetic, medical, dental or surgical diagnosis or treatment and hospital care from a licensed physician and/or surgeon as deemed necessary for my son/daughter's safety and welfare. I agree that the resulting expenses will be my responsibility.

Guidelines

Be sure to abide by all of Disneyland's Grad Nite rules, you don't want to be denied admission at the gate!

RULES FOR THE ROAD:

1. All Students and their belongings will be searched prior to boarding the bus.
2. Students MUST show photo ID to board the bus.
3. Students MUST show BOARDING PASS to board the bus.
4. NO FOOD OR DRINKS ALLOWED ON THE BUS!!!!
5. EHS is not responsible for transporting students who miss the bus (either departing from school or departing from Disneyland).
6. Only EHS students will be allowed on EHS buses.
7. Students must board and return on their assigned bus – no switching buses!
8. Anyone who appears to be under the influence of any controlled substance will be subject to immediate disciplinary and possible police action.
9. All school rules apply for this event. Violations will result in consequences including but not limited to: detention, suspension, loss of Senior privileges, etc.
10. Be SMART and SAFE! HAVE FUN!

PLAY IT SAFE:

- NO outside food and liquids including factory-sealed water bottles.
- NO bags of any type larger than a standard backpack
- NO blankets- 1 small pillow is ok
- NO shoes with skate wheels
- NO weapons, knives, chemical irritants, markers, sharpies, pencils or laser pointers or objects that appear to be weapons.
- NO tobacco (cigarettes, e-cigs, cigars, chewing tobacco, snuff, etc.) and related materials (lighters, matches, pipes, etc.)
- NO alcohol or controlled substance
- NO bandanas (worn or hanging from belt loops, pockets, etc.)
- NO glass containers of any kind (includes perfume)
- NO food, gum, mints.
- NO spiked style jewelry or belts
- NO aerosol cans/bottles
- NO Glass Containers of any size or type including perfume/cologne bottles and reusable water bottles.
- NO selfie sticks
- NO Portable/Bluetooth speakers
- NO Suitcases, coolers or backpacks with or without wheels that are larger than 24" long x 15" wide x 18" high.
- NO Musical instruments.
- NO Large tripods and professional photography equipment and lighting.
- NO recreational devices such as drones, remote control toys, skateboards, scooters, inline skates, shoes with built-in wheels.

MEDICATION

Medication is no longer subject to inspection by our nurses. However, we ask that all prescription and over-the-counter medication for students is carried in by a chaperone from the school through our security screening area. Medication may be given back to the student after clearing the security screening process. Any medication needing refrigeration may be stored at *Disney California Adventure*® Park First Aid.

Disneyland® Resort Grad Nite Policies & Expectations

It is the school's responsibility to ensure that all students and chaperones attending Grad Nite arrive at the *Disneyland*® Resort sober and without drugs, alcohol, and other prohibited items in their possession. We expect schools to conduct thorough bag checks and student screenings before allowing students to board buses for Grad Nite. Similar to the security screening process for all *Disneyland*® Resort guests, students and chaperones should expect bag checks and magnetometer screenings in our backstage screening area.

In partnership with the Anaheim Police Department, we will also be conducting screenings for banned substances. Screenings will include bag searches and the use of drug-sniffing canines. If bag searches and/or the drug-sniffing canines indicate the presence of an illegal substance, we will ask the subject student or chaperone for permission to conduct a pat-down search.

If any banned substances are found on the bus or in the possession of a student or chaperone, the matter will be turned over to the Anaheim Police Department for further action. Schools/groups that violate this policy are subject to be banned from future Grad Nite events. Attending Grad Nite is not a right, it's a privilege.

- Failure to follow the above guidelines will result in delayed and/or denied admission to Disneyland. Security has the right to deny entrance to anyone they deem not appropriately dressed for the event.
- To ensure the safety of all guests, it will be necessary to search students and their belongings before entering the park. Grad Nite is a non-smoking event. No one will be allowed to smoke at the park. All tobacco products found will be discarded.
